

# SEND A LETTER TO FERC

## Write to FERC now with your concerns about the Dominion pipeline.

As of October 31, 2014, Dominion has now pre-filed with FERC, which is the first step in the permit process. Your letters to FERC are even more important than ever!

- Identify the Dominion pipeline using its official name at the top of your letter:  
Re: Harmful impacts of the proposed Atlantic Coast Pipeline in Augusta County, VA AND its docket number #PF15-6.
- Tell FERC how the pipeline will affect you, impact your property, and harm the farms, forests, and communities that make Augusta County special. Make your letter as long or as short as you like. What matters is that FERC hears from you.
- Also please send a copy of your letter to the Augusta County Alliance so that we know how many people have sent letters and so we can help spread your story and message:
