

For AUGUSTA COUNTY Dominion's proposed pipeline is ALL PAIN & NO GAIN

FACT:

The proposed pipeline will provide few, if any, local jobs. Pipeline construction jobs are provided from highly-specialized professional unions NOT local communities. When complete the pipeline will provide **118** permanent jobs in the *entire* state.

FACT:

According to Dominion, the blast zone for a 42-inch high-pressure natural gas line is 1,100 feet. The proposed line runs dangerously close to the Stuarts Draft, Beverley Manor, and Churchville schools. In the event of a needed school evacuation because of a leak, our community's safety would be compromised. Currently Dominion won't consider moving the routes away from our schools.

FACT:

Unlike the much smaller, less pressurized Columbia Gas line, this proposed 42-inch line with almost 1,600 PSI will NOT allow for local hook-up. NO local homes, farms, or businesses will be allowed to hook up to this TRANSMISSION line. Augusta County's communities will be USED to transmit the gas, but other places far away will actually USE the natural gas.

FACT:

The tax revenue Dominion claims its pipeline would provide for the county is small—about \$20.29 per resident per year. Those taxes will be offset by significantly devalued property values, increased county expenditures needed for upgrading emergency services, and potential costs associated with maintaining public water supplies.
